All early childhood families must park in a parking spot and walk to Door BB to drop off and pick up your child.

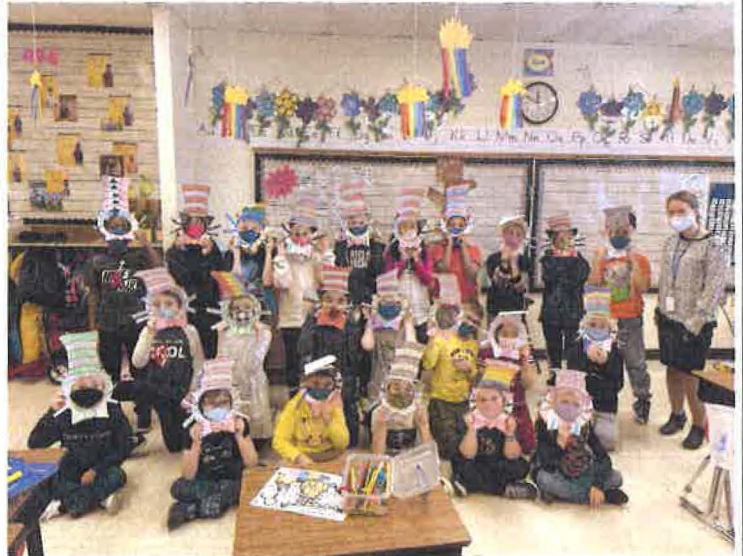
Please drive with care and keep everyone safe!!

Coach K bringing Thing 1 to gym class!

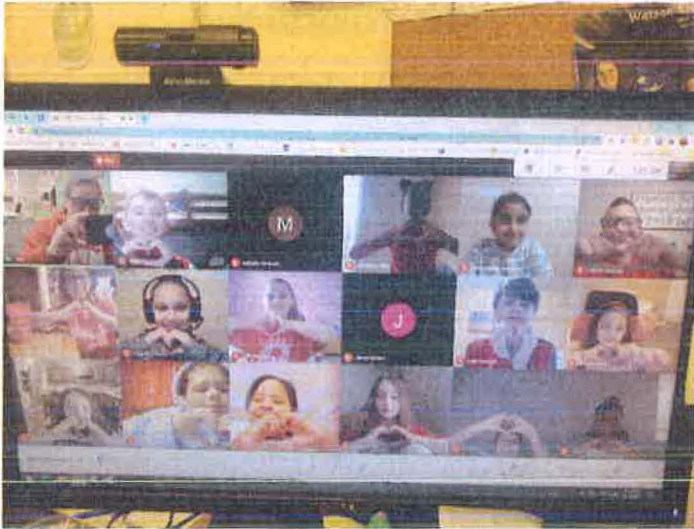


**Watson Staff celebrates our first ever

Friday: Wear your best rockstar outfit tomorrow or wear black to show that Watson Rocks!

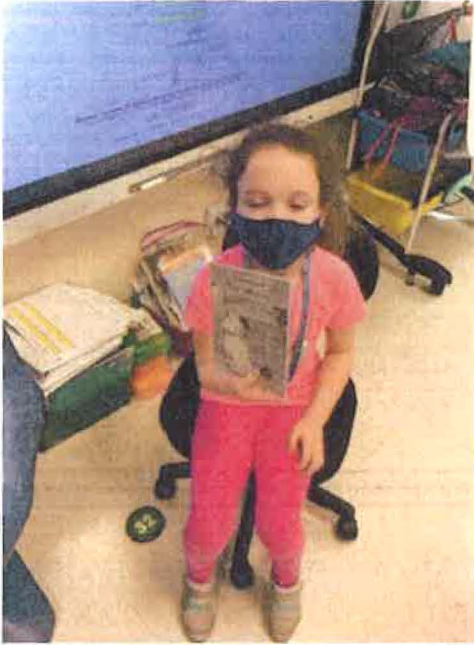

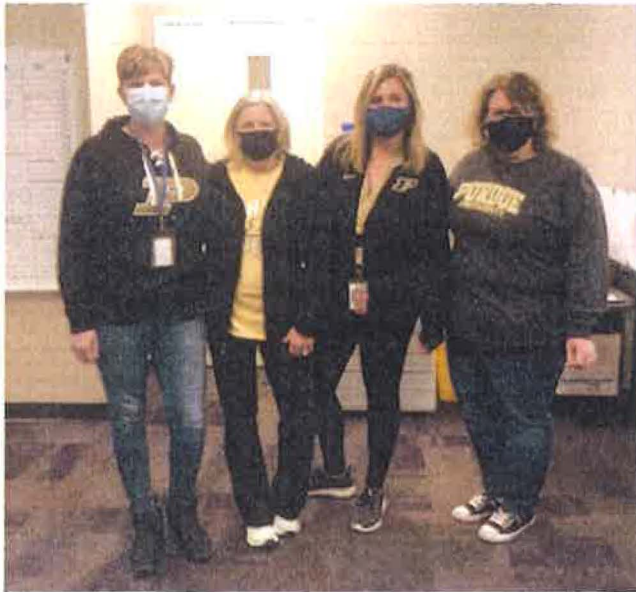
Our Student Council sure brightens up our halls!! Here is the board they created sharing why they love Watson.

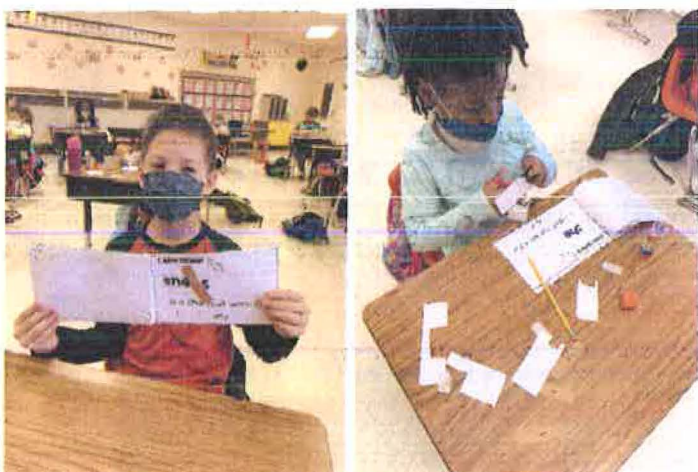
